Cybersecurity Experience for Year 9!

Dr Curley took some Y9 students to attend CYBERUK in Manchester with Dr Curley. Organised by the National Cyber Security Centre (NCSC) and the UK Government this is the flagship Cybersecurity event and Co-op Academy Swinton was one of only 7 schools to be invited to this major event.

The teams took part in activities using AI, Coding, Cyber security, the human aspects of cybersecurity and Cypher breaking. Coming second overall in the challenges, they learned about potential careers in the lucrative Cyber Security industry which is a major employer in Manchester with both the Government and Industry recruiting for over 6000 jobs in Manchester.

The event was part of Co-op Academy Swinton's process of becoming an accredited Cyberfirst School.



Enviornmental Awareness for Year 9!

On Tuesday, May 13th, a cohort of Year 9 students welcomed external guests from Bunzl, who conducted a workshop focused on global sustainability. The session included an exploration of how various brands illustrate and influence their operations through packaging, an examination of diverse career paths in sustainability, and a hands-on activity where students designed or modified packaging to enhance its customer-friendliness and sustainability in daily life. The workshop concluded with a question-and-answer session, allowing students to engage in discussions about sustainability and career opportunities.

Town Planning Workshop for Year 10!

Some of our Year 10 students were given the opportunity to take part in an urban planning workshop. They were given job roles linked to urban planning and then introduced to 3 industry professionals. The challenge given to the teams was to design and plan the regeneration of an urban area whilst considering the requirement to provide sustainable features and affordable housing. It was a pleasure to watch students work together with the industry professionals to better understand the challenge and begin to create their designs. The practical sessions were fast paced and challenged students to demonstrate work related skills such as co-operation, critical thinking and leadership. All 4 groups got the opportunity to pitch their plans to the industry professionals who then asked questions and provided feedback. All 4 groups did amazingly well, with the winning group winning an all expenses, VIP trip to London in July.










